Delivering impact against our 4 key outcomes:

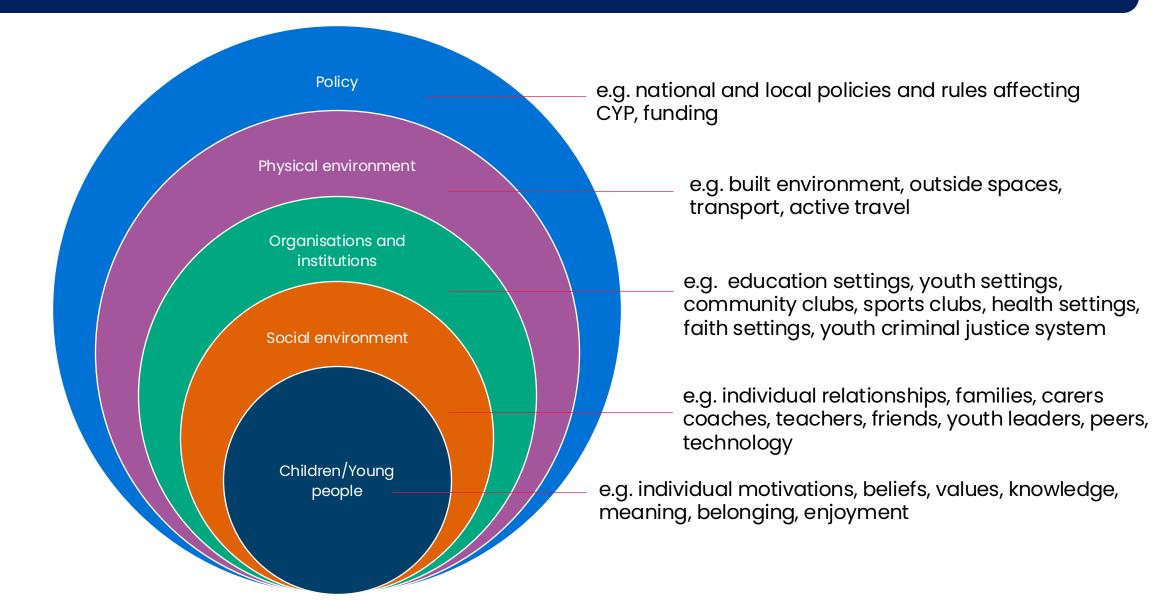
